PRELIMINARY DESIGN

NOTICE OF OPEN-HOUSE PUBLIC HEARING

ON LOCATION (DESIGN) OF ROUTE COUNTY

Notice is hereby given to all interested persons that a public hearing will be held at (give location of hearing) on (day of week), (day of month), 19, between the hours of and (a.m. or p.m.) Central (Daylight) (Standard) Time. Access for the physically disabled is available. All interested persons will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning their views on the location (design) of Route , County with reference to the economic and social effects of such location (design), its impact on the environment and its consistency with the goals and objectives of the community. An open-house format will be used, and persons may discuss the project and offer comments at any time between the prescribed hours. The presently contemplated improvement is as follows:

(SUMMARY OF PROPOSED DESIGN)

Maps, plats, an Environmental Impact Statement, (or Environmental Assessment or other environmental information as appropriate,) and other detail information prepared by the Missouri Department of Transportation, or interested agency, will be available for public inspection and copying at the office of the District Engineer of the Missouri Department of Transportation, (Address of District Office), Missouri, (and other locations, if applicable). Written statements and exhibits as well as oral statements will be received at the hearing. Written statements and exhibits will be made a part of the public hearing transcript if received within ten working days after the date of the hearing.

Tentative schedules for right of way acquisition and construction will be discussed at the hearing.

When applicable, include the following:

Relocation advisory assistance will be available for all persons displaced as a result of this improvement. Information on relocation assistance programs will be provided.

Some of the alternatives being considered include significant encroachment(s) on flood plain(s). The encroachment(s) will be identified at the hearing.
