Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of today's briefing?

The purpose of today's meeting is to gather public input about the proposal project to improve the Route F railroad crossing in Sleeper. The work will straighten Route F at the crossing.

How will traffic be affected?

The Missouri Department of Transportation proposes to close Route F for a period of 30 days in order for the work to be accomplished. Traffic will be detoured around the work on state routes. There will be a detour for those on Route F that will be affected and those on Route JJ that will be affected. Please see accompanying exhibits B and C for specific information about the detours.

When will work take place?

The project will be awarded in April of 2015 and the notice to proceed with construction will be given in May of 2015.

Will additional right of way be needed to construct this project?

MoDOT will not need to acquire permanent right of way for construction. Temporary easements will be required for construction at some locations where proposed entrance work ties into existing driveways. For those property owners affected, you are encouraged to reference a MoDOT brochure titled "Pathways for Progress".
