

DESIGN OF ROUTE 13 *Relocation Under Way in Lafayette County*

road notes

THE PROJECT

Lafayette County travelers can look forward to a new section of Route 13 from Route 24 to existing Route 13.

This project ties the northern four-lane divided section, which ended just south of Route 24, with the existing two-lane Route 13 to the south. This 3.1-mile extension unites the gap between the two sections and will improve safety, increase mobility, decrease travel time, provide for efficient movement of traffic, and offer a convenient and economical north/south route.

Amendment 3, approved by Missouri voters in 2004, helped to accelerate the schedule for the roadway project, which is scheduled for completion in early 2010. Although current funding limits the project to two lanes, sufficient right-of-way will be acquired to permit expansion to four lanes when needed. The estimated construction cost for this project is \$6.5 million.

This public meeting is to review the preliminary design and to give residents an opportunity for input and to learn more about the project. Attendees can speak face-to-face with individuals directly involved with the project.


