

Improvements on Route U South of Moscow Mills

Comments From the Public are Encouraged



Public Meeting
March 4, 2013

GOAL

Route U carries approximately 4,800 vehicles daily along a road with 20 ft. wide pavement and 2 ft. wide earth shoulders. Our goal for this improvement is to resurface and add shoulders along the roadway from Route J to the US 61 and Route U interchange south of Moscow Mills.

PROPOSED DESIGN

- Two 11 foot lanes with 4 foot paved shoulders.
- The curve at Sand Run Road will be softened.
- Edgeline rumble stripes added to increase safety.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- March 4, 2013 - Public Meeting on project design.
- Summer 2013 - Right of Way/Property acquisition begins.
- Spring 2014 - Bids will be opened.
- Summer 2014 - Construction begins.
- Fall 2014 - Construction complete.

TRAFFIC CONTROL

- Temporary lane closures with flaggers will be used during the majority of construction.
- Some short-term closures of Route U maybe necessary with traffic detoured onto other state routes.
