

**MINUTES OF SPECIAL HIGHWAYS AND  
TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION MEETING HELD IN  
JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, ON MONDAY, JANUARY 6, 2003**

A special meeting of the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission held on Monday, January 6, 2003, at the Truman Office Building, Room 490/492, in Jefferson City, was called to order at 1:00 p.m. by the Chairman, Mr. Ollie W. Gates. The following members were present: Mr. W. L. (Barry) Orscheln, Vice Chairman, Ms. Marjorie B. Schramm, Mr. Bill McKenna, and Mr. Duane S. Michie. Mr. James B. Anderson was absent.

The meeting had been called pursuant to Section 226.120 of the 2000 Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended. The Secretary verified that notice of the meeting was posted in keeping with Section 610.020 of the 2000 Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended.
