



Improvements:

The improvements to Route 34 in Bollinger County will extend from County Road 500 at Glenallen to the airport at Marble Hill. The project includes grading, paving, realigning three curves along the route and replacing the bridge over Gimlet Creek. Raising the elevation of Route 34 at Woodland School to help minimize flooding is also being reviewed.

Project Timeline:

MoDOT plans to begin purchasing the necessary right of way in fall 2010. Construction is expected to begin

in spring 2012. Additional information regarding the project's timeline will be released once the project is awarded to a contractor.


Traffic Impacts:


At times, traffic may be reduced to one lane with flagger or signal controlled work zones.
