



DESCRIPTION

The project will include replacing the Route 91 bridge over Drainage Ditch 2 with a new, wider bridge. Additionally, the bridge will feature lower rails to better accommodate agricultural traffic.

TIMELINE

A contract for the improvements is expected to be awarded to a contractor in April 2012. Work is anticipated to begin in spring 2012, with completion in mid-summer 2012.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

As work to replace the bridge is underway, the roadway will remain closed. By closing the road, MoDOT is able to save money for other needed improvements. If MoDOT constructed a temporary bridge to keep the road open, it would add approximately \$250,000 to the cost of the project.
