



## Downtown St. Louis I-64 Construction Overview

### **Why is there On-Going Construction on I-64 in Downtown St. Louis?**

Over the last ten years, various work has been completed in an effort to earthquake strengthen and to keep Interstate 64 in service for the future. Currently, major repairs are planned for the bridges and driving surface along I-64 from east of Kingshighway into Illinois.

### **What Construction Work is Planned?**

- Paint and install earthquake seismic retrofit work on I-64 Double Deck
  - 2010 to Spring 2012
- Repair and resurface the Poplar Street Bridge
  - Spring to Fall 2011
- Repair and resurface the I-64 double deck
  - Early 2012 to Summer 2013
- Remove and replace the Jefferson Avenue Bridge
  - Spring 2012 to Summer 2012

### **How Will Traffic Be Impacted During This Construction?**

There will be various lane and ramp closures on I-64 between 21<sup>st</sup> Street and Illinois on weekdays and weekends through Summer 2013. Interstate 64 will need to be fully closed for several weekends. More information will be provided as details are finalized, and MoDOT will keep the motorists informed of new updates for these construction plans.
